Shipley Area Committee Community Chest Fund

This will enable us to replace the flooring in the Bents Room at the Village Hall. We hope to make the Bents Room more comfortable and attractive for those who use it. Young children and teenagers use this as a breakout room during evening Youth Club sessions which run from the hall three times a week. It is a space they can use if they want some quiet time alone or a private conversation with an adult. During the day, this room is rented on an ad hoc basis for counselling sessions and also for holistic therapies such as body massages and facials. The walls have been painted in recent years to try to make it look fresher but we would really like to improve the feel of the whole room by replacing the floor.


